Appointment at Harvard Medical School as Instructor, Assistant or Associate Professor will be commensurate with experience and will require ongoing teaching. Interests should be in the area of early psychosis research. Candidates pursuing research with youth with psychotic disorders involving neuroimaging, genetic and/or pharmacological approaches should enhance the recently formed Early Psychosis Investigation Center.

Applicants must possess an MD and/or PhD and have at least two years' postdoctoral experience or the equivalent. The successful candidate will be poised to build a successful, independent, extramurally funded research program and have an existing track record of NIH funding.
